This week in a nutshell:

This week, children should be becoming increasingly familiar with the Fluent in Five challenge and by the end of this week most children should be able to complete all 4 questions within the 5 minutes.

This week:

- Mental addition focuses on adding a multiple of 100 to a single or double digit number.
- Written addition and subtraction involves 3 digits for the first time, but no exchanging is required.
- Written multiplication focuses on the 4 times table beyond 12×4 .
