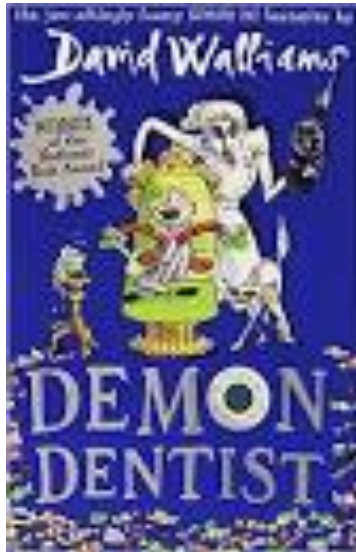


Yr 5 Spring 2- Parent Information

AREAS OF LEARNING

As scientists we will be thinking about how we should look after our teeth and dental hygiene. We will also be looking at the different types of teeth and the different components within them.

As computer technicians we will be developing our research techniques and using them to support our learning across the curriculum. We will try to be selective about the information we find and adapt it to our own needs.
